Today we are going to take a closer look at place.

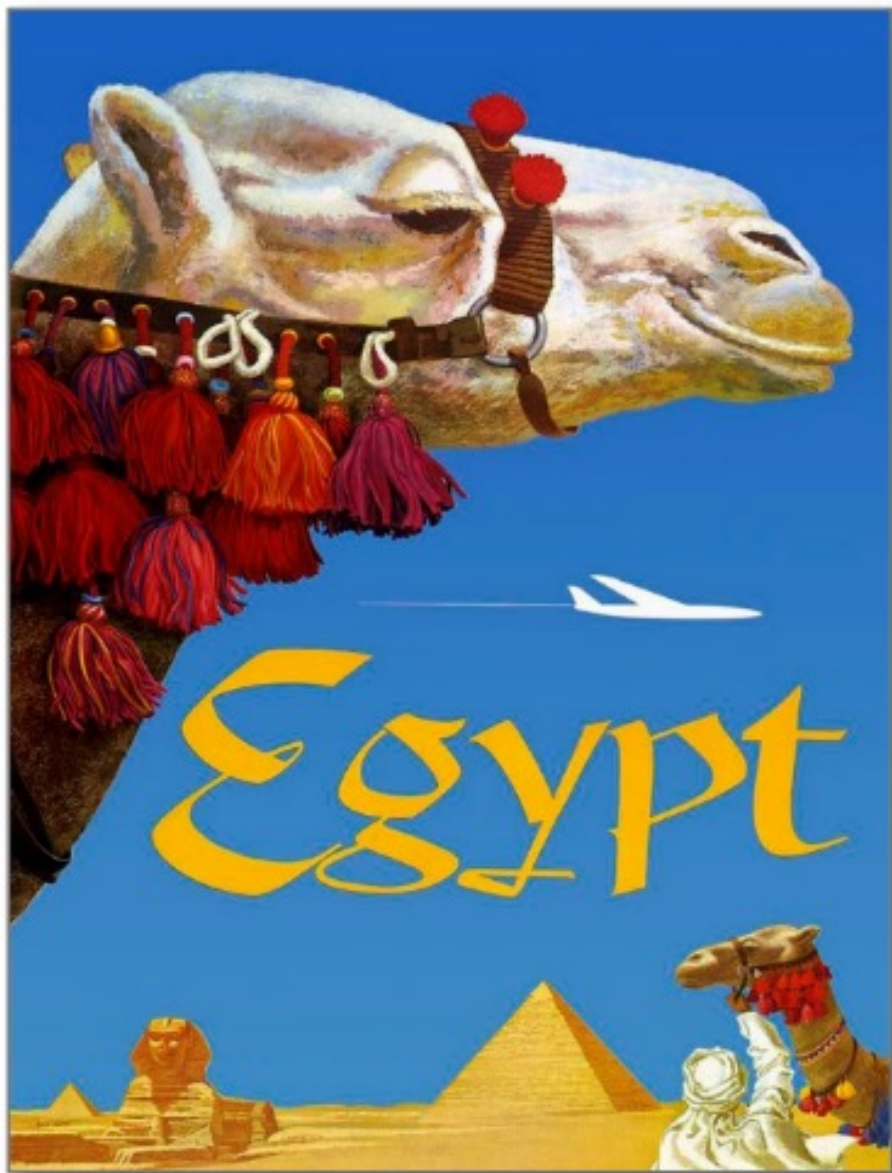
Let's discuss these two parts of place:

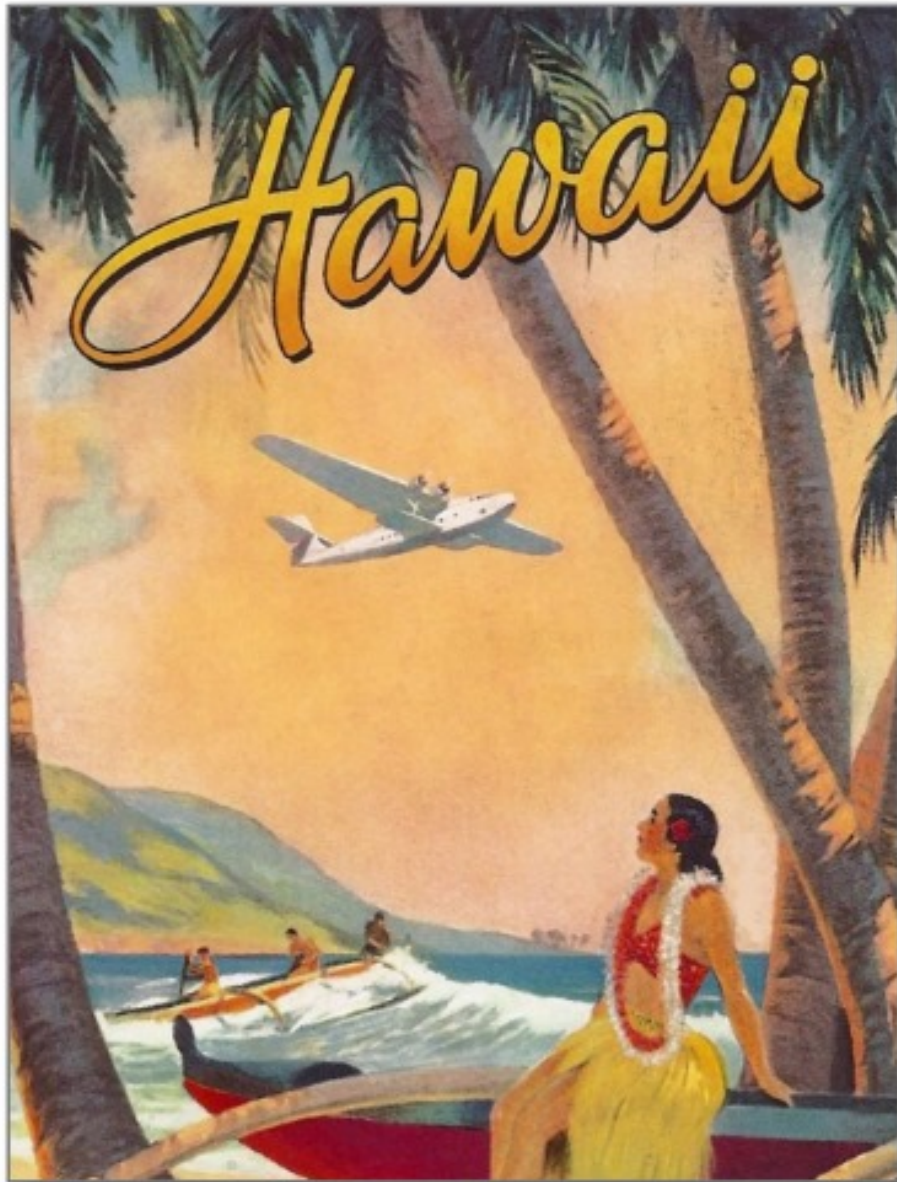
Cultural (dealing with people, or anything that was created by a person) and Physical (dealing with the natural world).
